FRESH AIR

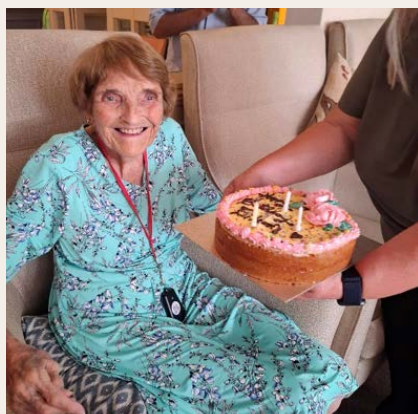
We love to get out for walks as much as we can. There is a lovely field with horses at the bottom of the road which the residents like going to.
